Hasibul Haque (HI)

Eight-year-old Hasibul Haque, a child with speech and hearing impairment, lives with his mother in Polba-Dadpur block of Hooghly district. His mother works in a gas factory and single-handedly manages household expenses while caring for her son amidst financial hardship.

She first noticed his hearing and speech difficulties at the age of two and consulted several ENT specialists, all of whom gave similar reports about his condition. In 2024, when Hasibul was seven, Graham Bell Centre for the Deaf (GBCD) identified him through an ICDS worker of Beta ICDS Centre. At that time, he could speak only unclear single words, avoided social interaction, and remained withdrawn. Although enrolled in Beta Primary School, he was not attending classes, leaving his mother mentally distressed and overwhelmed.

Following identification, GBCD counselled his mother, enrolled him in the Intervention Programme, and initiated regular home-based support along with speech therapy. Hearing aids were provided, and conversation-based speech training was introduced. Educational support through charts, LTMs, flashcards, and child-to-child programmes encouraged social interaction, while awareness sessions engaged the community and parents.

Today, Hasibul reads in Class II, attends school daily, plays with peers, and speaks in simple sentences. His mother now dreams of seeing him well-educated and independent.
