**Abir Sing
(LMD)**

Abir Sing is a 4-year-old boy from Damargancha village in the Balagarh block of Hooghly district. He comes from an economically disadvantaged family. Soon after his birth, his parents noticed that Abir was unable to stand like other children of his age and had to crawl to move around.

Concerned about his condition, his family made the difficult decision to pursue a surgical operation for him at a very young age. Unfortunately, even after the surgery, Abir did not show any significant improvement in his mobility. This situation deeply affected the family. His mother, in particular, felt very distressed and lost hope about her child's future.

In 2023, Abir was identified by the Graham Bell Centre for the Deaf (GBCD) through the parent of another child with disabilities. After his identification, GBCD enrolled him in its intervention program. Abir began receiving regular physiotherapy support along with home-based occupational exercises designed to strengthen his muscles and improve his mobility.

To assist him in movement, GBCD also provided him with a walker and a KAFO (Knee Ankle Foot Orthosis). With consistent therapy and support, Abir gradually started showing improvement. Using the walker, he was able to take slow steps for the first time.

Recognizing the need for further medical intervention to improve his mobility, GBCD arranged corrective surgery for Abir in 2025. This became a turning point in his journey.

Today, Abir has achieved a remarkable milestone—he is now able to walk independently. His progress has brought immense joy and relief to his family, restoring their hope and confidence for his future.
